

**ORDINANCE NO. 261
CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF LARKIN
COUNTY OF MIDLAND, STATE OF MICHIGAN**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 226, BEING THE LARKIN TOWNSHIP WATER ORDINANCE.

The Charter Township of Larkin, County of Midland, Michigan ordains the following amendment to its Ordinance No. 226, the Larkin Township Water Ordinance.

SECTION 1

Section 18(c), setting forth additional costs for premises not having previously paid for a water main, is hereby amended and shall hereafter read as follows:

- (c) In addition to the costs set forth in the previous section of this Ordinance, for premises obtaining a water connection in addition to that paid by way of assessment district or premises which have not borne the expense of the construction of water mains through special assessment, a water connection permit shall not be granted to connect to the Township Water System until the following payments have been made to the Township:
- (1) In cases where the premises connects, directly or indirectly, to a water main installed as part of Township Water System No. 1, payment in the amount of four thousand three hundred dollars (\$4,300.00) for each connection.
 - (2) In cases where the premises connects, directly or indirectly, to a water main installed as part of Township Water System No. 2, payment in the amount of five thousand four hundred and eleven dollars (\$5,411.00) for each connection.
 - (3) In cases where the premises connects, directly or indirectly, to a water main installed as part of Township Water System No. 3 or as part of Township Water System No. 3-A, payment in the amount of eight thousand seven hundred seventy-five dollars (\$8,775.00) for each connection.
 - (4) The connection fees for Township Water Districts No. 1, No. 2, No. 3 and No. 3-A, above, are to be paid whether or not the premises is adjacent to the Township water main.
 - (5) In cases where the premises lies adjacent to the Eastman Road transmission line between Hurley Road and Bombay Road, payment in the amount of twelve thousand three hundred seventy-five dollars (\$12,375.00) for each connection.

- (6) In cases where the premises does not lie adjacent to the Eastman Road transmission line between Hurley Road and Bombay Road but obtains water from a connection to that transmission line, payment in the amount of eight thousand seven hundred seventy-five dollars (\$8,775.00) for each connection.
- (7) In cases where the premises lies adjacent to a water main installed as part of Township Water System No. 4 - Blueberry Lane, payment in the amount of nineteen thousand seven hundred thirty-four and 60/100 dollars (\$19,734.60) for each connection.
- (8) In cases where the premises does not lie adjacent to a water main installed as part of Township Water System No. 4 – Blueberry Lane but which obtains water from Water System No. 4 – Blueberry Lane, payment in the amount of nine thousand eight hundred sixty-seven and 30/100 dollars (\$9,867.30) for each connection.
- (9) In all instances (1) through (8), above, payment shall also be made by the owner of the property to the City or Water District No. 1 of Midland County, as applicable, pursuant to the City or Water District No. 1 Code of Ordinances and regulations.
- (10) All costs for extensions of water mains not part of the Township Water System and owned by the Township, leads from water mains, ancillary equipment or ancillary appliances, which are not provided for in the City or Water District No. 1 installation and City or Water District No. 1 charges, shall be borne by the property owner. The amounts of special assessments, as well as the foregoing charges payable to the Township, represent repayment of the Township capital expenses and its readiness to serve only.

SECTION 2

Should any provision or part of the within Ordinance be declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, the same shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the balance of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3


All ordinances and amendments thereto, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its publication.


