

Steps for Hooking Up to City Water:

1. Complete the “Larkin Charter Township-Application for Water Service & Inspection”. Take this completed form to the Township Code Authority office in the Midland county building (220 W. Ellsworth) to obtain your permit. Please call 837-6521 to obtain office hours and permit fees in advance. Once a permit has been issued, you must then take the permit to the City of Midland Water Department office (333 W. Ellsworth) to obtain the meter yoke and pay the necessary connection fees. Should you wish to contact the city, please call 837-3341.

The Application for Water Service & Inspection obtained from the Township Code Authority covers the inspections for the water service line that will connect your home to the service valve (curb stop) that has been installed in front of your home and for the modifications needed inside your home to make sure the old water system has been completely disconnected from your plumbing system.

2. You can either install the service line yourself and modify the interior plumbing or hire a contractor to install the service line and modify the interior plumbing.

There are two inspections the Township Code Authority needs to make:

- 1) At the time the service line is being installed and connected to the service valve (curb stop) at the road.
- 2) When the interior plumbing is complete and you have installed your meter yoke, contract the city Water Department at 837-3341 to schedule your inside plumbing inspection, meter set and water turn on. A minimum of 24 hours notice is required to schedule an inspection.
