ONLINE ELECTION RESOURCE

The Michigan Secretary of State website lets voters check their voting status, find out their **polling location**, and access a **sample ballot** for their precinct prior to each election. Access the site:

SCHOOL ELECTIONS

Larkin Township Residents that live either in the Midland Public School District or Meridian Public School District vote at the Larkin Township Hall or Office. To obtain an Absentee Voter Ballot, one must first fill out an Absent Voter Ballot Application.

Not Registered to Vote in Larkin Township? If you would like to vote but are not registered, registering is a very simple procedure. You need to be at least 18 years old by the date of the next election, a citizen of the United States and a resident in Larkin Township.
